The successful candidate will

- Have good devotional habits and strong Christian faith
- Have personal warmth and enjoy people of all ages and backgrounds
- Have an contagious enthusiasm for music
- Appreciate a broad range of Christian music and be familiar with contemporary songs and traditional hymns
- Enjoy researching resources for worship across church traditions and cultures
- Understand “liturgical” style church services
- Have cheerful interpersonal and collaboration skills and be a good communicator
- Be happy to participate in the life of the church

Areas of Accountability

1. Participation in planning Sunday morning worship
2. Music leadership on Sunday mornings and special services:
 1. Leading as desired or as necessary
 2. Ensure musicians and vocalists are organized and prepared
 3. Seek to build up and encourage the musical gifts of the congregation and community
 4. Confer with whomever is preaching on choice of songs, ensuring the music and other worship elements are appropriate for sermon theme and the church calendar
 5. Arrange for other special music: prelude, postlude, offeratory, guest musicians
3. A/V team
 1. Give direction Sunday mornings - coordinate microphone tests with musicians and all participants
 2. Schedule and recruit the A/V teams - arranging meetings and training
4. Church choir (TBD)

1. Restart post-covid church choir and recruit new members
2. Prepare and lead rehearsals
5. Seasonal concerts (optional)
