





► Expectation of Several "End Times Persons" is attested to in the New Testament John 7 (NASB) <sup>40</sup> Some of the people therefore, when they heard these words, were saying, "This certainly is the Prophet." <sup>41</sup> Others were saying, "This is the Christ/Messiah." Matthew 16 (NASB) (= Mark 8:27-29); Luke 9:18-21 <sup>13</sup> Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he was asking his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" <sup>4</sup> And they said, "Some say **John the Baptist**; and others, Elijah; but still others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." <sup>15</sup> He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" <sup>16</sup> Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ/Messiah, the Son of the living God."

- Acts 3:19-26--quoting Deut 18:15--equating it with Jesus (cf. Acts 7:37)

<sup>22</sup> Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying,

"God forbid it. Lord! This shall never happen to You."

<sup>23</sup> But he turned and said to Peter,

"Get behind me, Satan!

for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's."
